REDUCTION OF SDC RATE APPLICABLE ON INTEREST INCOME RECEIVED BY CYPRUS TAX RESIDENT DOMICILED INDIVIDUALS FROM CORPORATE BONDS

On 26th June 2019 an amendment to the Special Defence Contribution (SDC) Law was published in the Official Government Gazette.

According to the amendment, effective from 26th June 2019, the SDC rate applicable on interest income received by Cyprus tax resident domiciled individuals from corporate bonds is reduced from 30% to 3%. The reduced rate is now in line with the SDC rate applicable on interest earned from Government bonds.

Cyprus tax resident non-domiciled individuals are not affected by the above change.

AuditPro Comments

This is a welcomed tax relaxation that will encourage individuals to invest in corporate bonds with higher returns than bank deposits and thus provide alternatives to lending for private businesses.
